- Mots pluriels irréguliers

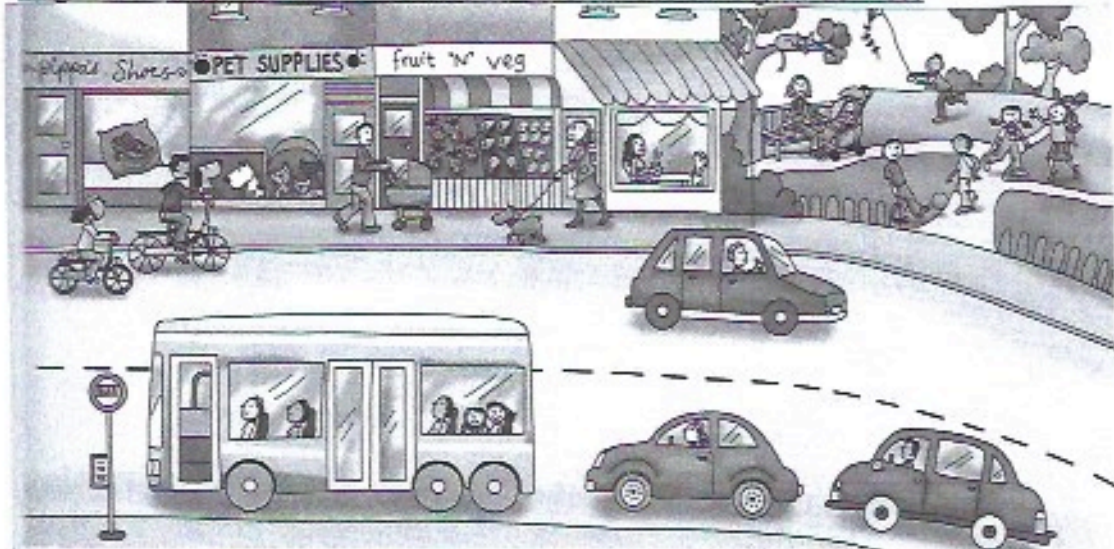
Exemple de mots pluriels irréguliers :

a man – two **men**

a woman – two **women**

a child – two **children**
